- **Where, when and why are we having these awards?**

The Awards are taking place on 10<sup>th</sup> September at old Billingsgate, London. We are taking the opportunity of our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary to celebrate the success of our learners, employers and business partners and demonstrate the good work and importance of the construction industry.
- **What awards are there?**

- **Who can nominate?**

Anyone can nominate for the Gold Awards – staff, employers or individuals, the nominee just has to meet the criteria. The nominations are only open until 30<sup>th</sup> June so get nominating and encourage your customers and contacts to do the same. This is a fantastic opportunity for companies and individuals to be celebrated by their industry peers.
- **Who is attending?**

We are inviting apprentices, employers, training providers, business partners, MPs, councillors, long-standing staff, federations, training groups and Board members to name a few.
- **Is it free to attend?**

It is free to attend but it is by invite only. Members of staff attending will have their travel and accommodation costs paid for by CITB as will the apprentices (in line with our previous awards shows) but other attendees will have to pay for their own.
