

CDM Regulations 2015



The new CDM Regulations came into force on the 6th April 2015. They will revise the existing CDM 2007 Regulations and make significant changes to Client and Designer duties, including the abolition of the CDM-Coordinator Duty-Holder and the introduction of a new 'Principal Designer' role. This online CPD course will outline the key changes and describe what they mean in terms of the main CDM duties as well as guidance on their implementation.
